In preparation for this theme students can read and analyse journalistic sources such as newspaper articles and internet news feeds, look at some of the latest data from the WTO and WTTO and assess its impact. Participants will be asked to present samples of media reports and to comment on how the issue of sustainability is being represented. It is advisable for students to start their research before they arrive in Portugal as this will help ensure a quality debate.
